REACH Statement for Fuji Power Semiconductors

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals) regulation is in force since 1st June 2007 REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European parliament and of the council concerning REACH.

The European REACH Regulation is a "law for the high-level protection of human health and the environment, while enhancing competition and innovation and ensuring the free movement of substances, which are contained in compounded and molded goods, with the intent of achieving a production and use of chemical substances that minimize significant hazardous effects on human health and the environment". Information transmission is required via supply chains with regards to the chemical substances in molded goods.

REACH also addresses the continued use of SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) on the Candidate List which was published with 28th October 2008 and last amended 17th December 2015, because of their potential negative impacts on human health or the environment. Concretely, the case contained in the density for the SVHC to exceed 0.1% weight by weight in the molded piece corresponds.

Fuji Electric Co., Ltd. is compliant with these regulations, and with regard to SVHC, we are collecting and confirming each piece of information we receive from suppliers for the materials and parts we use, and based on this, we carry out the development of individual products.
